SPECIAL EVENTS

Throughout the year Pinnacle Presbyterian sponsors many special events for the entire family. The year kicks off with a celebration on the first Sunday after Labor Day and continues with Pumpkin Fest, Christmas Pageant, Fat Sunday, Easter Egg-Stravaganza, Vacation Bible School and Splash! Parent seminars, family retreats and other special programs minister to families and foster Christian fellowship.

CHURCH SCHOOL

The Church School educational programs at Pinnacle Presbyterian center around the Bible, Jesus, and God's great love for us. The curriculums used are a multi-intelligence approach to Christian Education. They address all the various ways children learn. Throughout the year the children participate in storytelling, drama, puppetry, music, physical activities and movement, cooking, geographical activities, current events in relation to the Bible and artistic activities. Activities are hands-on and relate the Bible story to the children's lives.

Children ages 3 and up participate in Church School during the 9:30 a.m. service each Sunday. Bibles are presented to Kindergartners and 4th graders.

Summer Church School runs June through Labor Day for children 3 years old through 6th grade during the 10:00 a.m. service.
